

Topic: Desert to garden

<p>U3.4.2. Recall the words and actions of Jesus at the last supper and make simple links with his words and actions in the miracle of the loaves.</p> <p>Have you ever been hungry? What did it feel like? Large crowd with Jesus. PB P98-99 Read the story of Feeding the 5,000.</p> <p>Make links between the miracle and people's belief in Jesus. How does this make people believe?</p> <p>Talk about the true identity of Jesus. How do we know Jesus is truly human? How do we know Jesus was truly God?</p> <p>Possible task – Imagine you are present. What do you see? Feel? How tell other people about this miracle. Retell the story.</p>	<p>U3.4.2. Recall the words and actions of Jesus at the last supper and make simple links with his words and actions in the miracle of the loaves.</p> <p>U3.4.3. Describe how Jesus showed his love at the Last Supper and how he shares this love when people celebrate their first Eucharist.</p> <p>PB P101-102 Read The Last Supper & PPT on P102 (Describe how Jesus showed his love at the Last Supper & make links).</p> <p>Possible task – Explain the link between the Last Supper and Feeding the 5,000.</p> <p>PB P103 New Covenant – explain the meaning of the New Covenant and the special promise Jesus made to be with us.</p> <p>Make links to Holy Week and children to understand the importance of what happened (and order).</p>	<p>U3.4.4. Make links between the story of the Last Supper and the Mass, giving reasons for these links</p> <p>U3.4.6. Describe, with increasing detail and accuracy, the prayers, religious signs, and actions of the Mass, focusing on the Liturgy of the Eucharist.</p> <p>Children to understand what happens when they make their Holy Communion and ways people celebrate their first Eucharist.</p> <p>Find out about the different readings at Mass – the Bible is God's Word. Learn the Penitential Act (visit to church would be good – Mass). Offertory – giving Jesus examples of how we have helped others.</p> <p>Possible tasks – Give examples of Sin & how to help others / make the right choices. Explain the liturgy of the word & offertory. Responses at Mass.</p>	<p>U3.4.6. Describe, with increasing detail and accuracy, the prayers, religious signs, and actions of the Mass, focusing on the Liturgy of the Eucharist.</p> <p>Explain that all sacraments are meeting points where people are blessed by God. Sacrament of the Eucharist – Jesus offers his life for the salvation of the world.</p> <p>PB P109-110 Eucharistic Prayer – then Holy Communion (PB P111-P113 separate lesson)</p> <p>TB P45 PPTS (Body of Christ & Actions/Symbols at Mass)</p> <p>Possible task – How do we live out the Eucharist? Think of different ways to love and serve Jesus. What happens at the different parts of Mass?</p>	<p>U3.4.5. Recognise that the Church teaches that the Eucharist is the meeting point where God gives himself to communicants as food; they receive the Body of Christ and become ever more united in his Body the Church (YCfK 74).</p> <p>PB P116-119 stories about God's love and forgiveness. God loves everyone, especially those who help others.</p> <p>Learn the different parables taught by Jesus. Parable of the Lost Sheep. Discuss in each parable what Jesus is trying to teach us and why. What do these parables tell us about God?</p> <p>Possible task – imagine you are the Lost Sheep and describe what happened to you. Say thank you to God for the love he has for us.</p>	<p>U3.4.7. Give reasons for actions and symbols used in the Mass and make links between beliefs and actions.</p> <p>Recap sacraments we know of. Explain the sacrament of reconciliation is a meeting point with God where he forgives our sins.</p> <p>We need to examine our conscience – explain what conscience is. PB P121 – share examples of sin or not sin. PB P125 PPT (First Confession)</p> <p>Possible task – Consider steps to recovery once we have done something wrong (how to put it right). Make a guide of how to go to confession. Learn the Act of Contrition.</p>
