

Topic: Prophecy and Promise

Understand

Lesson sequence - include the key concept, L.O. and brief description of lesson

<p>1.2.1 The Annunciation Know that God chose Mary to be the mother of his Son, Jesus.</p> <p>U1.2.4. Know that in the Annunciation God called Mary and she said ‘Yes’ to his call and why this makes Mary important for Christians.</p> <p>Know that in the Annunciation God called Mary and she said ‘yes’ to His call and why this makes Mary important for Christians. Know the importance of passing a message. Share V&B PPT (TB P43). Why do you think God chose Mary? How do you think Mary felt when she saw the angel? Use imagery of the annunciation – what can you see? What is happening? How is Mary feeling? We can thank Mary for saying yes to God. Luke 1:26-38</p>	<p>1.2.2 Mary visits Elizabeth Know that Mary visited Elizabeth to share her good news. Know the Bible is a special book.</p> <p>U1.2.2. Be introduced to the Bible as a special book and encounter the stories and accounts of how people came to know God and the Good News of Jesus in the gospels. U1.2.6. Recognise that angels bring God’s message and are a sign that Jesus is the Son of God.</p> <p>Sharing news – share good and exciting news with the class. Hear how Mary shared news with her cousin Elizabeth, and how Elizabeth also had some news to talk about. Share a Bible with the children. Explain the Bible is a special Book. The account of Mary’s visit to Elizabeth is in the Bible and also the Annunciation to Mary. What do we learn about Mary? Luke 2:39-45</p>	<p>1.2.3 Mary is our Mother Know Mary is our Mother. Hear and join in with the Hail Mary.</p> <p>U1.2.4. Know that in the Annunciation God called Mary and she said ‘Yes’ to his call and why this makes Mary important for Christians. R1.2.1. Hearing and beginning to join in with the words of the Hail Mary.</p> <p>Look at how mothers love and care for their children. We ask Mary to pray with us and for us and to comfort us in times of need, especially using the prayer ‘Hail Mary’. Hear and begin to join in with words of the Hail Mary. When we say the Hail Mary, we ask Mary to join with us. Do you ever ask Mary to pray for you, or help you? Write prayers to Mary our Mother. Poem about Mary (what she is like).</p>	<p>1.2.3 Mary is our Mother Know/recall the words the angel Gabriel said to Mary. Become familiar with the Gloria.</p> <p>U1.2.5. Match the first words of the Hail Mary with the words of the Angel Gabriel. D1.2.2. Thinking about why the words of the angels are in the ‘Hail Mary’ and the beginning of the ‘Gloria’. R1.2.2. Singing or saying the first words of the Gloria.</p> <p>V&B PPT teacher book P53 – the meaning of the Hail Mary. Help children to understand who it was that first spoke some of those words. Match the first words of the Hail Mary with the words of the Angel Gabriel. Highlight the words the angel Gabriel said to Mary. Look at how Catholics around the world show honour to Mary.</p>	<p>1.2.4 The Birth of Jesus Know that because God loves us, He gave us His only Son.</p> <p>U1.2.1. Recognise that, for Christians, the Christmas story reveals God’s love by sending Jesus his Son. R1.2.3. Talking about how Christians in their local community celebrate the birth of Jesus. (RVE)</p> <p>Discuss what a new baby needs, discuss preparing for a baby. Read the birth of Jesus to children. Recap and recall what they already know/remember. Discuss how the story is in the Bible, recap Bible being a special Book. This is how we know the accounts of Jesus. Share PPTS (V&B TB P58) – Birth of Jesus & The Bible. Hot seat Mary</p> <p>Luke 2:4-8</p>	<p>1.2.5 Visit of the Shepherds Know that the Angels bring God’s message and are a sign that Jesus is the son of God.</p> <p>U1.2.3. Sequence the accounts from the Annunciation through to the visit of the shepherds. D1.2.1. Talking about why the shepherds saw angels when Jesus was born.</p> <p>Hear an important story about what happened when Jesus was born. What do you think the shepherds thought? What do you think the shepherds said? V&B TB P62 – PTT – Shepherds. Imagine you are one of the shepherds telling someone what happened that night. Talk about who gave Mary the message and who came to the shepherds.</p>
