

Dear Reception parents,

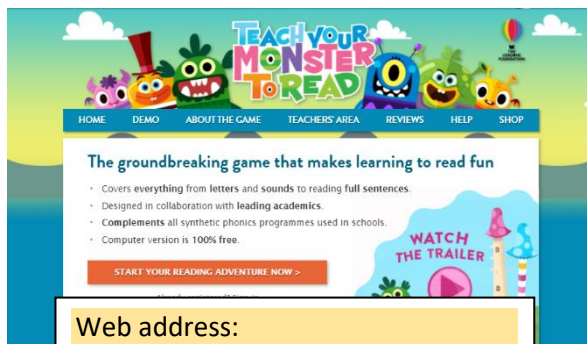

EvidenceMe

Over the next few weeks, we will be communicating via EvidenceMe, a tracking app that we use in school to record observations of the children. You can access this online or download an app to your mobile device called EvidenceMe. EvidenceMe has a ParentShare feature which can be used by both school and parents to communicate regarding your child's learning. All parents should be set up on EvidenceMe and some invitations have been sent today, please check as this email may have gone to your junk. Literacy

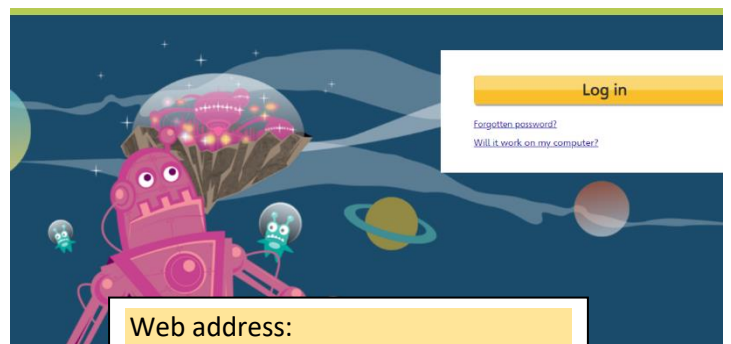

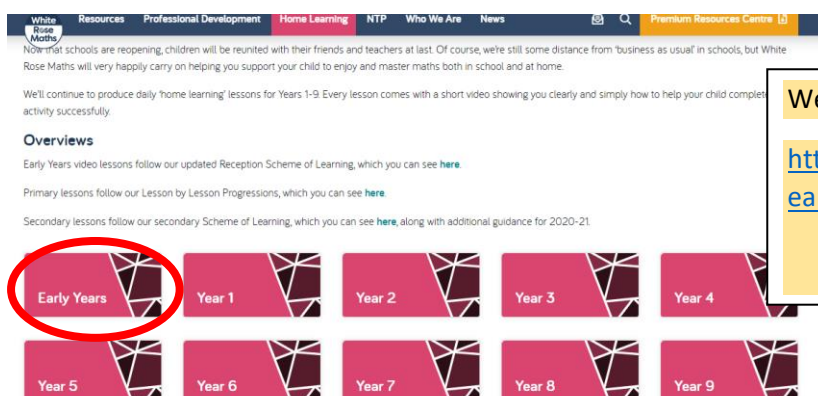
