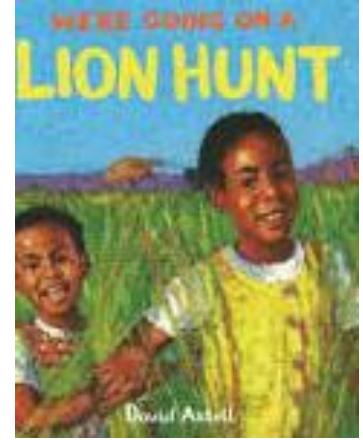
- Look out of your window and keep a diary everyday of the weather. Draw a symbol for the daily weather.
