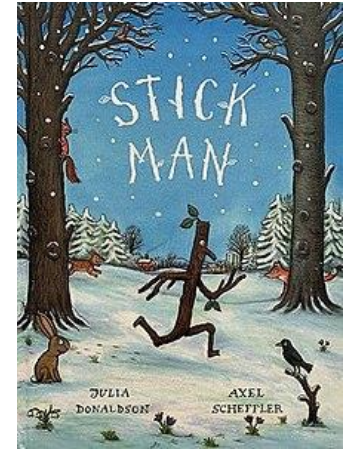

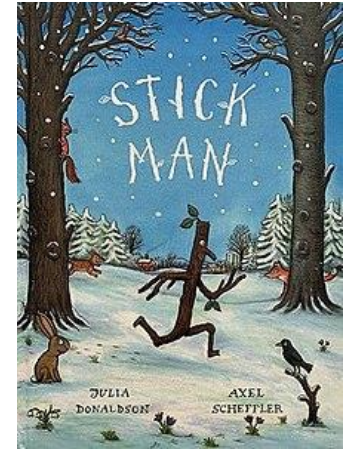
- Can you identify all the words in the book that rhyme?

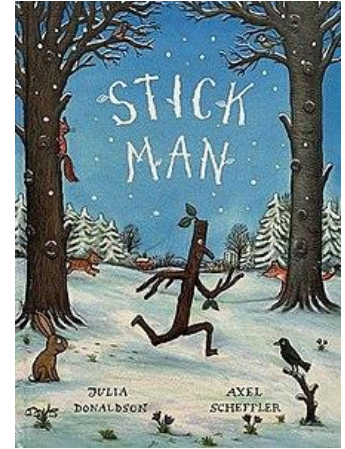
- Go through your house and try to find something that begins with each letter of the alphabet.

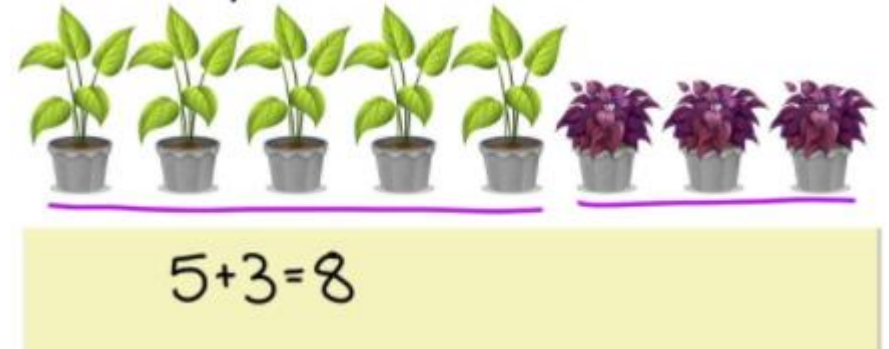

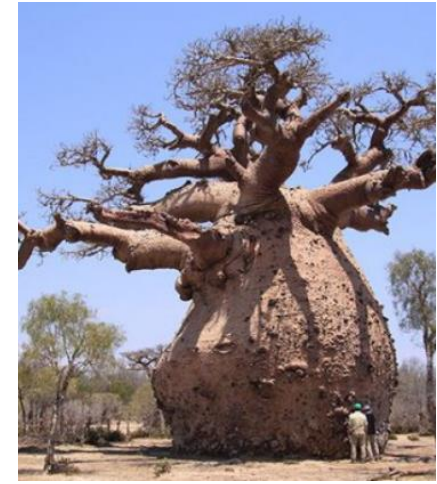
