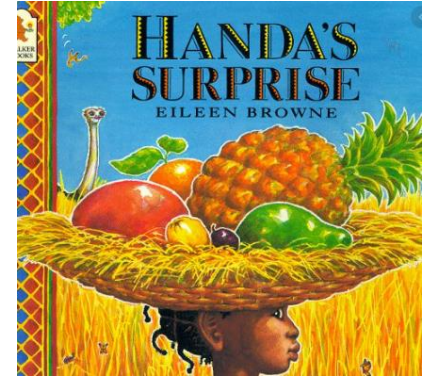

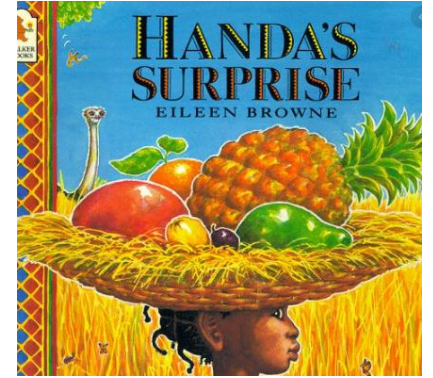

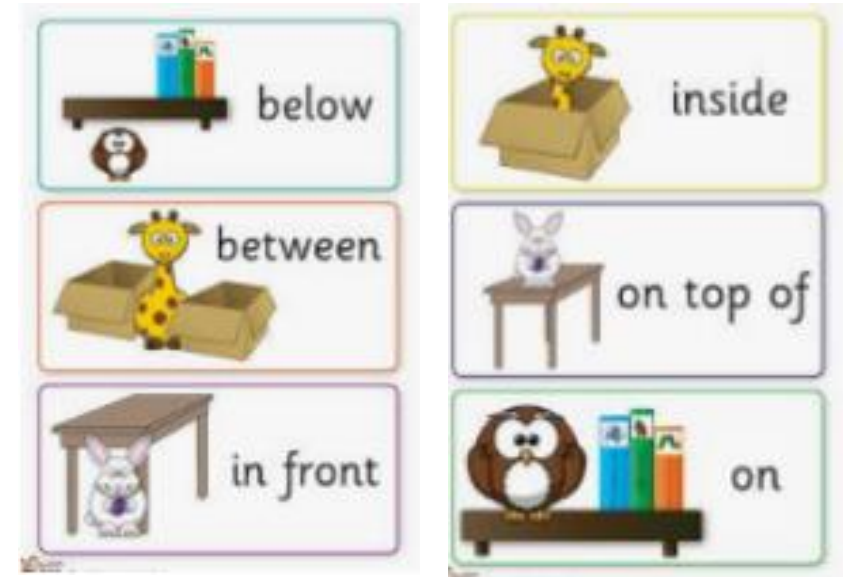
Counting backwards

Lesson 1

Ice ornaments

Ingredients

Shapes of different sizes, water, string,
plants from around the garden

Activity

- Fill the dishes with water.
- Add a piece of string making sure the string is totally immersed in the water but is still long enough to hang out of the dish.
- Decide what you would like in your ice ornament and add it to the water.
- Leave the dishes outside overnight to freeze.
- Once they are frozen, you can take them out of their dishes and using the string attach the ice ornaments around your garden.
- Watch what happens to your ice ornaments as the temperature rises and the ornaments start to melt.

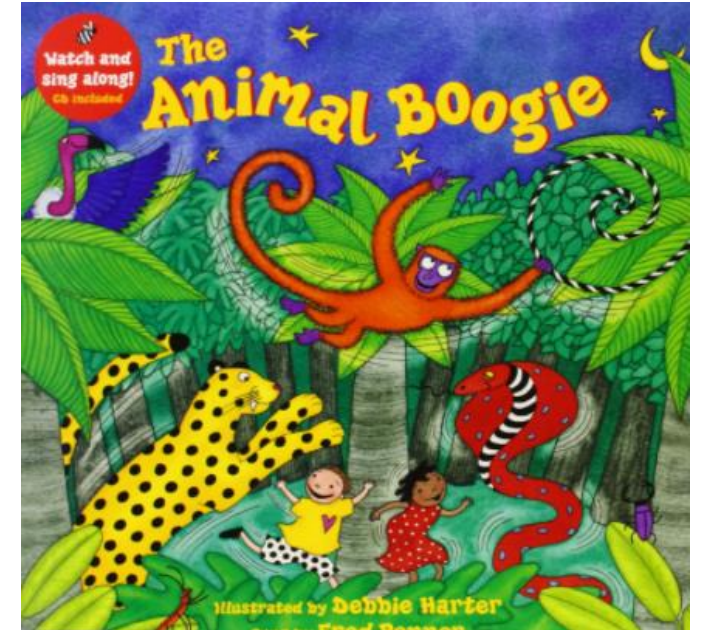

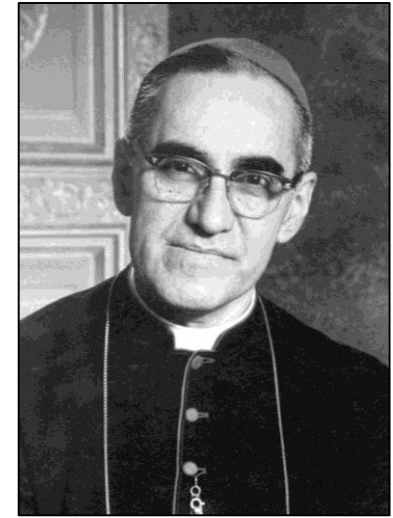
