YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL TRIP TO CULMINGTON MANOR

WEDNESDAY 21ST OCTOBER - FRIDAY 23RD OCTOBER 2026

A three day residential trip to Culmington Manor in Shropshire has been booked for our Year 6 children from **Wednesday 21st to Friday 23rd October 2026**. Due to ever increasing costs of residential trips, it has been decided to change to off peak dates to keep the trip affordable, although this does mean less months to pay this time and the deposit must be paid promptly to secure the booking. If we have an insufficient number paying the deposit within the given date, we will be unable to go ahead with the trip.

The cost of the trip will be **£240.00** which includes transport, accommodation, food and activity sessions and is payable via your Arbor account.

A deposit of **£50** is requested by **30th June** to confirm a place and the balance can be paid in instalments. Your Arbor account will show a reducing amount as you make payments. The full amount must be paid by **Friday 9th October 2026**.

Residentials are an invaluable part of the National Curriculum, offering new and exciting challenges and, by living with their peers and working together in a team environment, the children develop independence, confidence and an ability to recognise strengths and weaknesses in a constructive way. The value of giving children the opportunity to try out new activities cannot be underestimated as they learn to respect and value each other's ability, developing strong bonds and the resilience to support and guide them through their final year of primary school.

Manor Adventure's fully trained and qualified instructors provide instruction in a full programme of activities in a safe, controlled and secure environment.
