Thank you to those who joined us for Mass, we look forward to welcoming you in to school again soon.



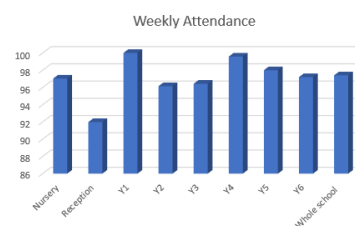
## PTA
