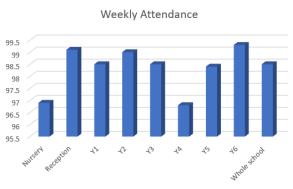
ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

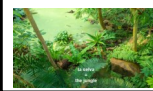
Applications for Year 7 Secondary School places for September 2025 must be submitted by 31st October 2024
